\$5

PER WEEK

provides a full scholarship for one member to attend 4-H Camp in Tioga County, a 4-H State Leadership Conference Scholarship in Sullivan County, and one psychiatric evaluation at Diakon Counseling.



\$10

PER WEEK

provides mileage reimbursement for 10 weeks for Tioga County Foster Grandparent volunteers, one anterior root canal from the Dental Sliding Scale Program in Sullivan County, and would provide enough food for 2 days of emergency meals for 2 patrons at Sojourner Truth Ministries.



\$20

PER WEEK

covers 16 application fees for documentation needing to be replaced after fleeing a violent home at YWCA Northcentral PA, bus transportation with the Sullivan County Library for active senior citizens trips, and would send one Tioga County 4-H member to National Congress.
